EUCALYPTUS GRANDIS

Eucalyptus Grandis is native to eastern Australia, but large plantations have now been established in South America and South Africa too. All of the Grandis imported into the UK is from South America. The trees themselves grow from 40 to 70 metres tall and up to 250cm in diameter, and have a lovely smooth light-silver to light-green bark. The timber itself varies in colour between almost white and light pink all the way to dark red, and is uniform between heartwood and sapwood. This latter colouring is what gives the timber its other name: Red Grandis.

These attractive straight-trunked trees produce timber roughly as strong as oak, and have a wide variety of uses. Eucalyptus Grandis is common in construction, flooring, joinery, panelling, shingles, boat building, and furniture making, amongst other applications. All of Quercus's stock comes from well-managed sources, and is certified as such.
