Canadian Hard Maple

Canadian hard maple is a strong heavy hardwood found in Canada and the eastern United States. It's similar to soft maple timber, but much denser and has a firmer texture. This timber is straight-grained and fine textured, with light reddish-brown heartwood and deeper coloured late-wood bands. Its sapwood is white, and used to create the highly-sought after white maple.

Canadian hard maple is difficult to work, and is superior to European oak when it comes to hardness, resistance to shock loads, and resistance to splitting. This makes it perfect for a wide range of applications where hardness is king: wooden floors on gymnasiums and bowling alleys, butcher blocks and baseball bats, and more.
