## **AMERICAN WHITE ASH**

American White Ash sapwood is almost white, and its heartwood varies between light brown and reddish brown (not unlike European ash). However, when it's dried, it's a little lighter than European ash. The timber grows in mid-Atlantic and central states of the US as well as some parts of Canada.

American ash is often used for furniture, flooring, doors, architectural interiors, high-end joinery and mouldings, cabinetry, panelling, tool handles, sports goods and turnings, and is becoming popular in the construction of electric guitars.
